If you have any questions or need to schedule an appointment to come into the building, please call our school office 620-805-7400

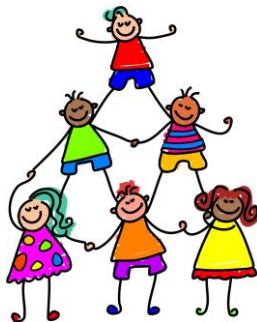


School Store
