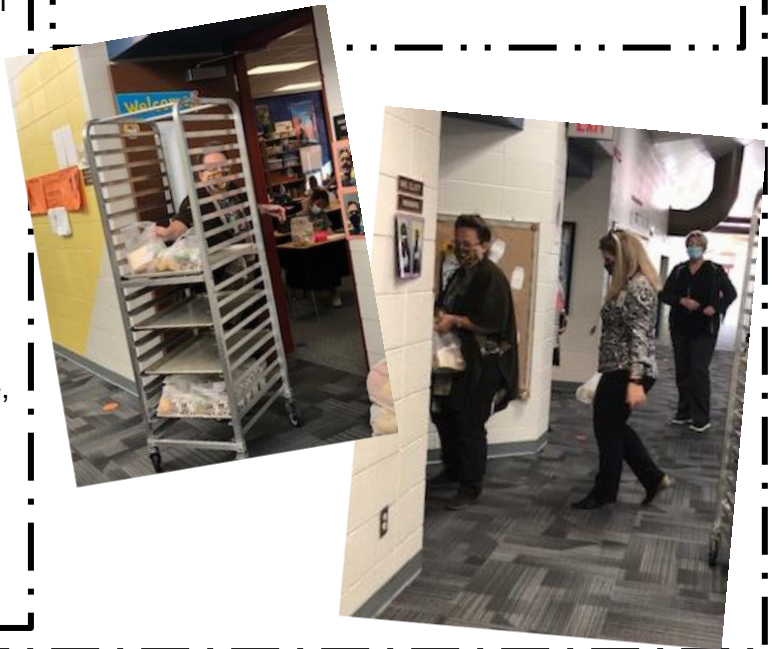

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Tips for Ipad at home...

- Designate a special place for the ipad to charge at night
- **Identify certain locations in the home where ipads can be used...for instance, only in the living room and at the kitchen table**

- Make sure your child does not have food or drink while working on their ipad

Notes from the Nurse

We have implemented some precautions this year to help maintain the health of our students and staff. Our first line of defense against illness is the parents of our students.

If your student is experiencing the following symptoms, please keep him or her at home:

***Fever or fever-like symptoms:** includes a temperature of 100 degrees/body aches/chills/fatigue

***Respiratory symptoms:** May include cough, congestion, runny noses, sore throat and shortness of breath

***GI symptoms:** may include diarrhea, vomiting or severe nausea

It is also recommended that you contact your primary physician or Finney County Health Department.

If a household member tests positive for Covid-19, your student will need to stay at home. Your family will be instructed by Finney County Health Department on quarantine and the length of time needed to stay home. School will require a "Return to School" note for any student that has been in quarantine. Students that are sent home with possible Covid-19 symptoms while at school will also be advised to contact their primary physician or GCHD and will require a "Return to School" note.
